A 20 month old child with ‘Global Development Delay’ who was struggling to chew food and resulting in him being the size of a 6 month old baby was one of most recent families to benefit from our help and support and to receive much needed equipment to encourage him to eat normally.

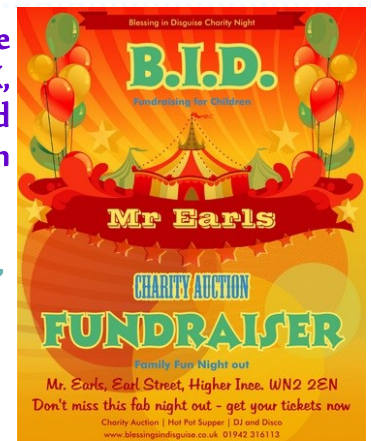
